To Our Community Members:

Summer is here, and even though our students are gone, the administrative and maintenance teams are working hard getting ready for the coming school year. Letters will be mailed home letting students and parents know about summer school opportunities. Miss Corbus is coordinating summer school for grades K-6 and 9-12. Larry Crowley is coordinating summer school for grades 7 and 8. Summer school starts on July 26th and ends on August 19th. Parents must provide their own transportation. We will serve breakfast and lunch. The Chehalis Tribe will also serve students with summer school activities. We are working closely with the tribe to serve as many kids as possible. Students are encouraged to seek summer school in either or both locations. Drivers education began on June 9th and ends on July 15th. Driver's education is being held at the Rochester High School in portable #5.

Our Maintenance Team is working very hard over the summer. The Oakville School District budget for grounds and maintenance is listed as follows:

Grounds and Supplies.....	\$ 10,000
Grounds Operations.....	\$ 6,000
Operation of Building and Supplies.....	\$ 16,000
Operation of Building Contracts.....	\$ 12,000
Maintenance Supplies.....	\$ 8,000
Maintenance Contracts.....	\$ 22,000
Travel.....	\$ 500

Due to unexpected but necessary costs, such as our sidewalk at approximately \$11,000, we are over budget by -\$14, 528.58. We will take this unexpected cost from our general fund to off set the balance. All needs are based on available funds. In the very near future, our needs include:

- 1. Repair of the old gym roof (approximately \$35,000)**
- 2. New roof on the elementary and cafeteria facility (currently estimated at \$50,000)**
- 3. Repair of the concession area in the old gym entry way (approximately \$35,000)**
- 4. Old gym bleachers (cost not projected)**

We hope to secure future grants to address these serious concerns. This summer, we are planning to begin the plumbing and energy projects which are fully funded by grants. We are also cleaning gutters, removing moss, painting the wood frame (fascia) on the outside of the buildings, preparing classrooms, facility and grounds.
