First of all, we wanted to wish a great deal of Congratulations to our 10 students from the class of 2019. They were a tremendous group of students who will go on to do great things in the future and we wish them well.

Second of all, we wanted to say thank you to Representative Jim Walsh for his sponsorship of a bill in the last legislative session that will allot over \$500,000 for the district in our effort to move our district kitchen from its current location.
